The children heard Dinosaur Roar and afterwards they acted the story out with dinosaur models.




Owl Babies performed with the help of puppets and children acting as well.


The children had an advanced preview of the books that were for sale at our Book Fair and made their choices. Our "#Shelfies" and Extreme Reading Challenge photos were a








World Book Day—Reception
