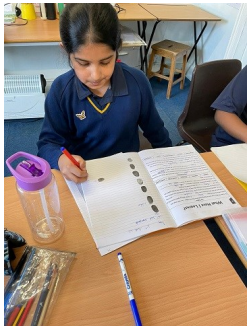
FoBS Mothers Day Shop
