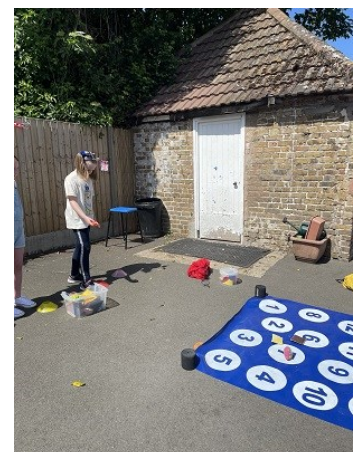

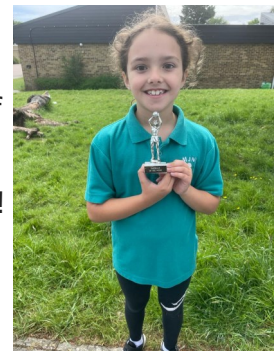
Extra Curricular Sport

Sai had his grading for Taekwondo and he passed to the next belt. Well done **Sai**, this is really lovely news and we are all very proud of you!

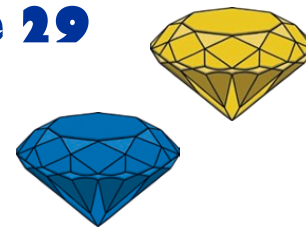
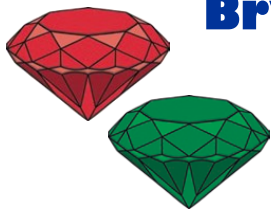
Important Notices
