4F have been learning about sound. They made telephones using different lengths of string.



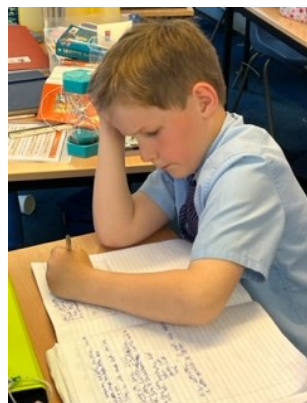
Today they made the test fair by using the same length of string but the variable was the cup.

Fathers Day Shop

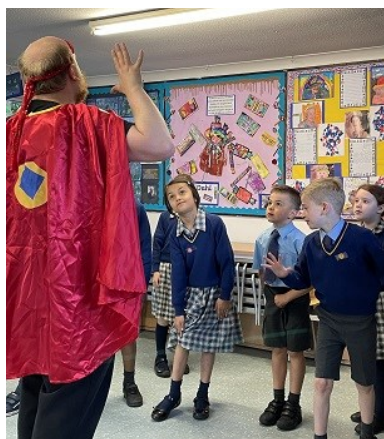

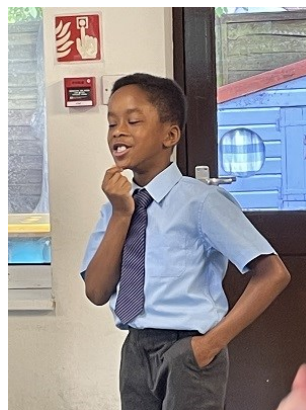

3C and 4F have written letters to the Queen. These were posted in the half term.

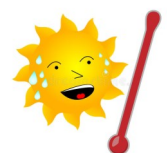


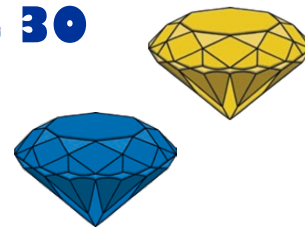
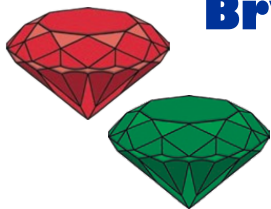
