Remembrance

Remembrance Day signifies the end of World War 1 on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918. Also known as Armistice Day. During the last month we have been selling poppies in aid of the



Royal British Legion who support Armed force veterans with housing and jobs. The Poppy is a symbol of Remembrance and hope for a peaceful future. In the bleak and barren landscape of the battlefields in Western Europe during the war, the resilient bright red 'Flanders' poppy began to flourish in their thousands and were the inspiration for the famous poem 'In Flanders Fields' written by Lieutenant Colonel John McCrae. The poem inspired a campaign to get the poppy adopted as the official symbol of Remembrance across the United States, Canada, Australia and the UK. The selling of Poppies came about in London in 1921, the same year the Legion was formed. 9 million poppies were ordered and sold on 11th November and this has been a tradition ever since.

We have held assemblies and observed a 2 minute silence to remember those who lost their lives for their country.

# Year 2 - Remembering


Year 2 have written acrostic poems today remembering the soldiers on Armistice Day.
