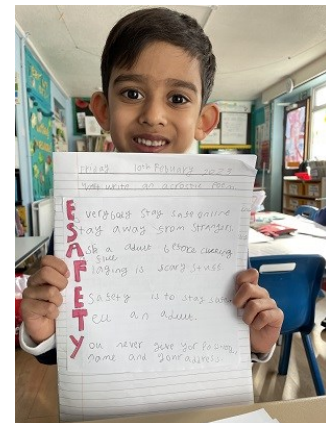
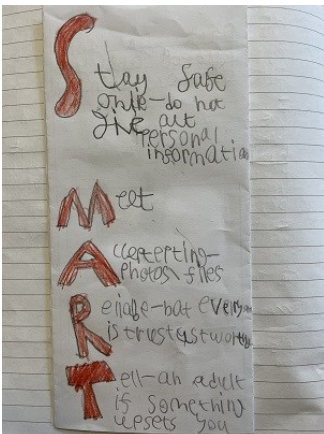
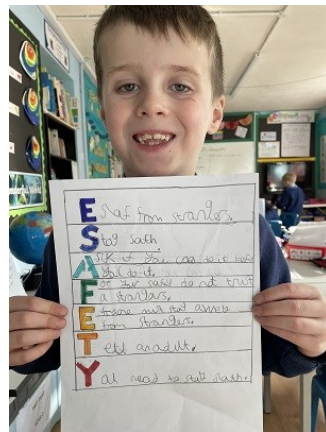
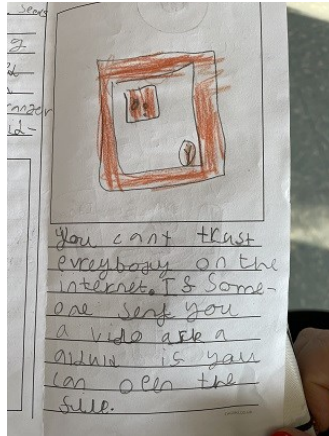
### Safer Internet Day

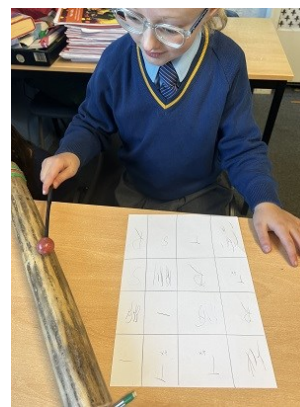

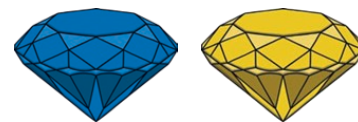
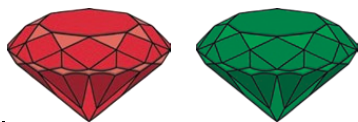
