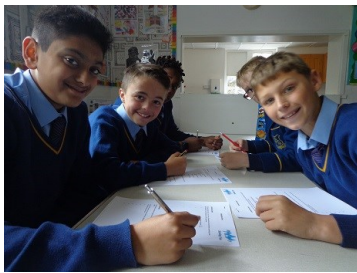

Quick Sticks Hockey

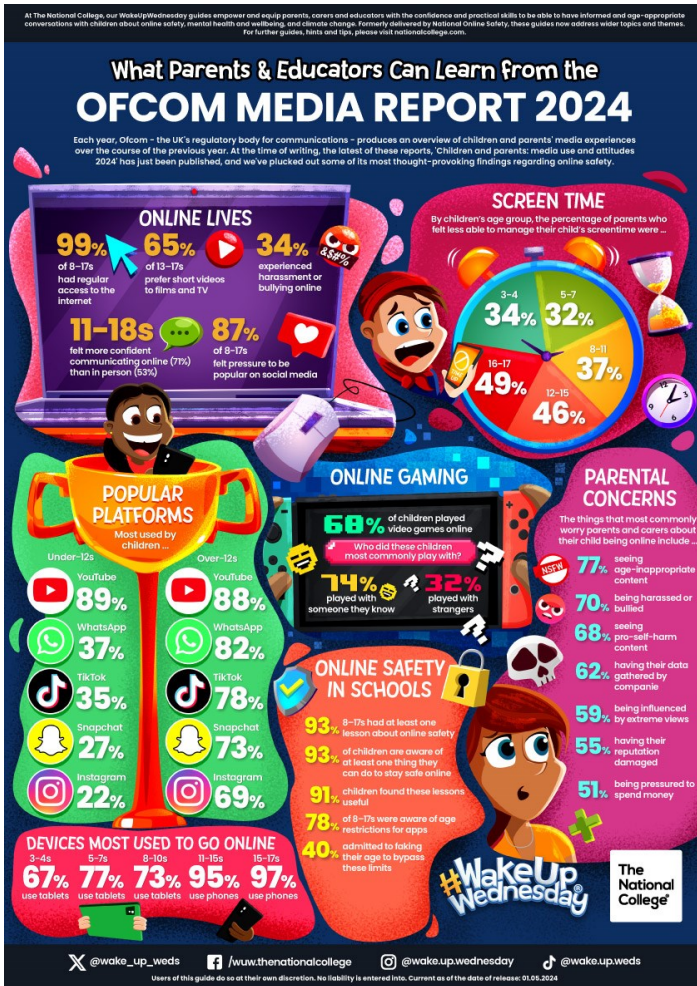
