Restart a Heart (RSAH) is an annual initiative led by Resuscitation Council UK which aims to increase the number of people surviving out-of-hospital cardiac


arrests by helping more people learn CPR.

Last week we were visited by Wayne Burney from Kent Fire and Rescue who gave the Year 6 children some skills on resuscitation related the Restart Heart scheme.



October is Black History Month in the UK, an event that has been celebrated nationwide for more than 30 years. We are so lucky at Bryony school to be a diverse and inclusive community. We have so much we can learn from each other in understanding and celebrating our cultures, traditions and religions.

During this month, we have held informative assemblies at both the infants and juniors and had a range of lessons across the curriculum to learn stories of Black history and


celebrating the rich contribution of the black community to the culture, society and economy of the UK.

In Key Stage 1, we focused on Alma Woodsey Thomas (1891-1978) in our art lessons. Thomas became an important role model for women, African Americans, and older artists. She was the first African American woman to have a solo exhibition at New York's Whitney Museum of American Art, and she exhibited her paintings at the White House three times.

Our children learnt about Thomas' abstract paintings colourful and recreated these for a display.

Infant children have been learning about famous black personalities and have written about them in English lessons.




