The power to edit and filter photographs is readily available and the ability to manipulate reality through digital techniques can have a profound impact on perceptions. Our year 5 computing lesson this week focused on

"False Photography," where the children learned about the techniques used to alter images and the importance of critical thinking when consuming visual content.

Following the discussion, the children had a fantastic opportunity to explore their own creativity, crafting their own photographs and experimenting with different angles, lighting, and composition. This hands-on experience helped them understand the choices that photographers make and the potential for manipulating images.

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




