**STOP PRESS.....**

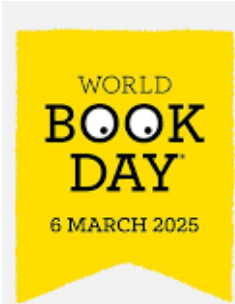

The entries will be judged after the close of day today and the winners will be announced in next weeks assemblies!





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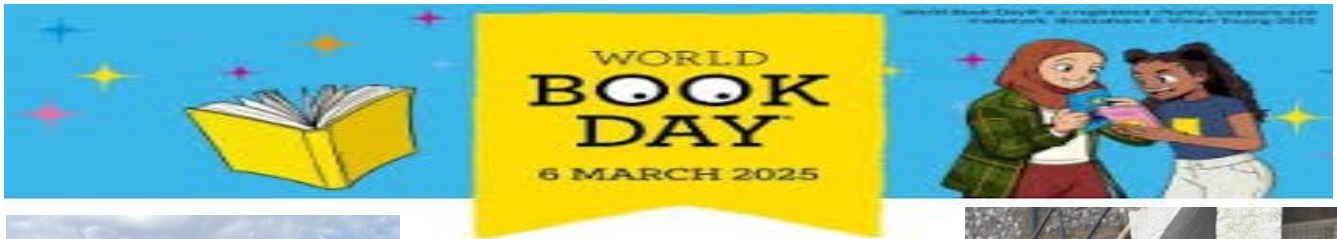

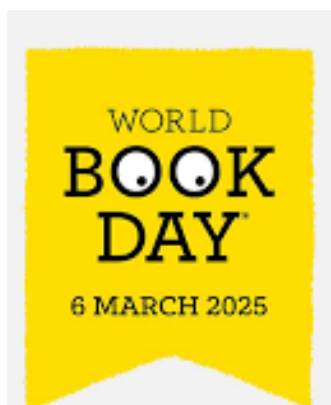




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## World Book Day 2025

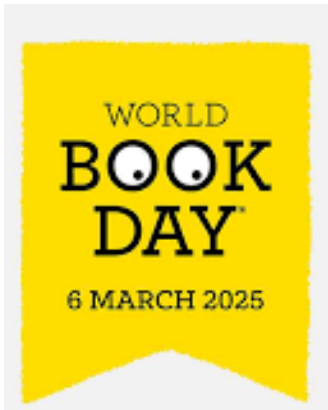

The children worked fabulously together, and we discovered that some methods didn't work as well as others! The children then worked as a whole class to put themselves in order of shoe length.





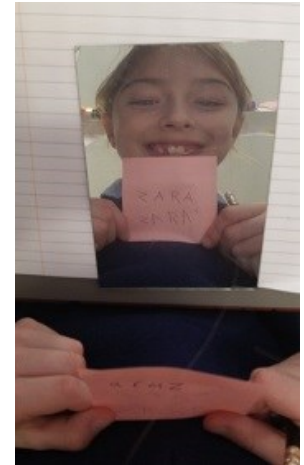
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## Year 3 Science

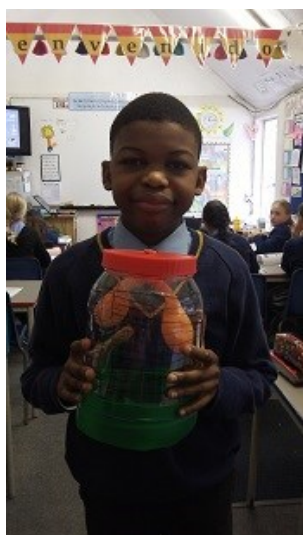
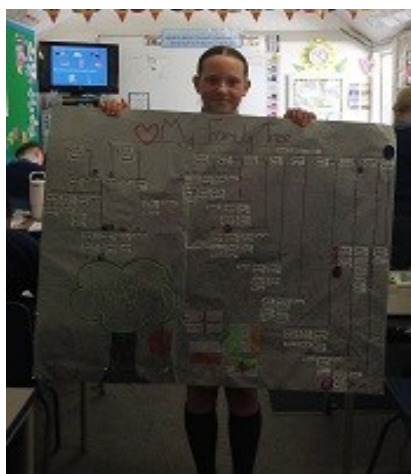

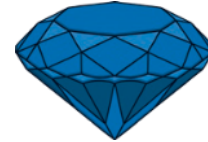
